



### PupSicles

These treats are great for hot summer days!

#### Recipe #1

- 1 quart fruit juice
- 1 banana
- 2 cups dog biscuits
- 1/2 cup plain yogurt

Pour dog's favorite juice (apple, apricot, peach) into large bowl. Mash banana and add to juice. Crush dog biscuits and add to mixture. Add yogurt and mix well. Pour into popsicle mold or ice cube tray and freeze for approximately three hours. Store in the freezer until you want to give your dog a frozen treat!

#### Recipe #2

- 1 quart water
- 1 quart orange juice or other fruit juice
- 1 cup dry kibble or treats
- 1 sliced apple (no core)
- 1 sliced banana
- 2 tennis balls

Place all ingredients in an empty gallon ice cream container or similar container. Freeze until hard. Empty frozen contents in a 'block' into an empty baby pool or large container and let your dog lick away! \*\*You may need to run warm water on the outside of the container to loosen it.
